PURPOSE OF THE INFORMATION

This page aims to describe how to manage the site regarding the processing of personal data of users who consult it, which will be treated according to rules of lawfulness, correctness, relevance, and not excessive.

This information is provided to those who interact with the web services of Rebbly Clothing Service, accessible via the internet from the address: www.rebbycs.com, corresponding to the home page of the official website of Rebbly Clothing Service Inc.

This information is provided only for the Rebbly Clothing Service website, and not for any other websites that the user consulted via links.

OWNER AND RESPONSIBLE

The Owner of the treatments described is Rebbly Clothing Service s.n.c. di Rebesco Silvia e C., with headquarters in Via Caozocco 21, 31020 in San Zenone degli Ezzelini (TV) Italy.

The processing operations will be carried out by persons appointed by the Data Controller and/or the Data Processor. They will operate under their direct authority in compliance with the instructions received.

SUBJECTS TO WHOM THE PERSONAL DATA MAY BE COMMUNICATED OR WHO MAY BECOME AWARE OF SUCH DATA IN THEIR CAPACITY AS DATA PROCESSORS OR PERSONS IN CHARGE OF PROCESSING.

Your data may be communicated to external companies whose collaboration Rebbly Clothing Service will be used. In any case, there is a guaranteed adoption of security and confidentiality criteria that is equivalent to that adopted by Rebbly Clothing Service's operation of external data processors.

Your personal data may be communicated to third parties to comply with legal obligations, comply with orders from public authorities, or exercise a right in court. Furthermore, subject to your consent, your data may be communicated to third party companies as indicated in point d) of the information notice.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

Navigation data The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data (so-called log files) whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes:

The IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users who connect to the site, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier), addresses of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc..) and other parameters relating to the operating system and computer environment of the user.

This data is used to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site. They could be presented to the Judicial Authority if the latter explicitly requests it.

Data provided voluntarily by the user, optional, explicit, and voluntary sending of electronic mail to the addresses indicated on this site involves the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, and any other personal data included in the message.

A specific summary of information will be progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the site prepared for particular services on request.

COOKIE INFORMATION What is a cookie?

What is a cookie? A cookie is a small text file stored by your computer when a user visits a website. The text stores information that the site can read when it is viewed at a later time. Some of these cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the site; others are useful to the visitor because they can securely store your username or language settings. The advantage of having cookies installed on your computer is that you no longer need to fill in the same information whenever you want to access a site you have previously visited.

Why does Rebbby Clothing Service use cookies?

Rebbby Clothing Service uses cookies to provide our customers with a browsing experience that is tailored as much as possible to their tastes and preferences. Rebbby Clothing Service uses cookies to ensure that you do not receive or enter the same information every time you visit the site. Cookies are also used to optimize the website's performance: they make it easier for both the final purchase process and the quick search for specific items and products within the website. To protect your personal data from possible loss and from any form of unlawful processing Rebbby Clothing Service has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures.

First-party cookies: are the cookies generated and used by the site's operator on which the user is browsing. Technical and performance cookies are limited in the transmission of session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) that allow safe and efficient navigation of the website. Cookies are also used for statistical purposes for the detection of unique users. The content displayed or downloaded, etc..., is an example of Google Analytics. The data that is stored anonymously is used in an aggregated manner. To disable Google Analytics cookies, you can use an add-on provided by Google. To install it, [click here](#).

Third-party cookies, such as the one set by the Facebook "Like" button, are cookies generated and used by parties other than the website's operator on which the user is browsing, based on contracts between the website owner and the relevant third party. Some advertisers use these cookies to track the user's visits to the sites where they offer their services.

How do I disable cookies?

You can change your browser to disable cookies using a very simple procedure. Please note that if you deactivate cookies, your username and password will no longer be stored in the site's login box.

Firefox:

Open Firefox.

Press the "Alt" button on the keyboard.

In the toolbar at the top of the browser, select "Tools" and then "Options."

Then select the "Privacy" tab.

Go to "History Settings:" and then to "Use custom settings."

Uncheck "Accept cookies from sites" and save preferences.

Google Chrome:

Open Google Chrome.

Click the "Tools" icon.

Select 'Settings' and then 'Advanced Settings.'

Select 'Content Settings' under 'Privacy.'

From the "Cookies and site data" tab where you can search and delete specific cookies.

or

Type `chrome://settings/cookie` in the address bar and press enter.

You will access the "Cookies and site data" tab where you can search and delete specific cookies.

Safari:

Open Safari.

Choose "Preferences" in the toolbar, then select the "Security" panel in the following dialog box.

In the "Accept Cookies" section, you can specify if and when Safari should save cookies from websites.

For more information, click the 'Help' button (marked with a question mark).

To learn more about cookies that are stored on your computer, click on "Show cookies."

OPTIONAL DATA CONFERENCE

The provision of data is optional. However, the refusal of the interested party to provide their personal data will make it impossible for the Owner to send commercial proposals and information on the company's activity.

METHODS OF PROCESSING

Automated tools process personal data for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

Specific security measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use, and unauthorized access.

RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

The interested party has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning him/her and their communication in an intelligible form.

The interested party has the right to know the content and origin of personal data.

The interested party also has the right to obtain:

- a) the updating, rectification or, when interested therein, the integration of the data;
- b) the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed;
- c) certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified. Unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort, the contents of the entities of whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated too will be managed.

Finally, the interested party has the right to object, in whole or in part:

- a) for legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection;
- b) the processing of personal data concerning him/her, is carried out to send advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.

In any case, the interested party will remain free at any time to revoke the consent given by the same, sending a communication to this effect without formality to Rebbby Clothing Service, at the email address info@rebbbycs.com.
